You submitted a request for a Pardon Coach from the Pardon Project of Beaver County (“PPBC”) to assist with your Petition before the Pennsylvania Board of Pardons.

The PPBC provides pro se assistance to applicants under the following criteria:

- Applicants who are Beaver County residents with an income at or below 200% of the poverty guideline.
- At least 8 years have passed since completion of the most recent sentence. Exceptions may apply on a case-by-case basis.
- Applicants with a record reflecting alcohol or substance abuse must show evidence that they have invested in and will continue to invest in appropriate treatment.
- All court-ordered restitution, fees and court costs must be paid or they must be on-track with an active payment plan. Exceptions may apply on a case-by-case basis.
- No conviction, at any time, in any jurisdiction, of any “crime of violence” as defined in PA Code § 81.202, sexual assault, or offenses committed with a firearm.
- A stated “need” or reason for the pardon.
- A record of “giving back” or contributing to the community.

You submitted a request for a volunteer Pardon Coach from the Pardon Project of Beaver County (PPBC) to assist with your Petition before the Pennsylvania Board of Pardons.

The PPBC provides volunteer pardon assistance under the following conditions:

- Beaver County residents with an income at or below 200% of poverty guideline.
- At least 8 years have passed since completion of most recent sentence. Exceptions may apply on a case-by-case basis.
- Individuals with a record reflecting alcohol, substance abuse or mental health, must show evidence that they have invested in appropriate treatment programs and intend to do in the future
- All court-ordered restitution, fees and court costs must be paid or they must be on-track with an active payment plan, Exceptions may apply on a case-by-case basis.
- No conviction, at any time, in any jurisdiction, of any "crime of violence" as defined in PA Code § 81.202, sexual assault, or offenses committed with a firearm.
- A stated "need"/reason for the pardon
- A record of "giving back"/contributing to the community.

Your Application has been reviewed by the PPBC. You do not meet these requirements. Unfortunately, this means we cannot provide you with a volunteer.

This decision not to provide with a volunteer Pardon Coach does NOT mean that you may not be eligible for a Pardon and does not mean that your Petition may not someday be Granted by the Board of Pardons. This denial only means that you do not qualify for volunteer assistance from a PPBC Pardon Coach.
